This academic year there has been a steady improvement in all areas including infrastructure, academics, extracurricular activities and placements in our college. The activities hosted by the clubs have contributed immensely towards the overall development of the students.

Each core department has its own professional clubs like Urja, Access, IEEE, IETE, and CSI student chapters. College Radio 'Aawaz' reaches all students with instant updates and announcements. Our Student Activity Committee has organized many events on campus and has provided great support in making every activity on campus successful throughout the year.

This year the performance of the students in the examinations has been praise worthy. Results of 2015-16 II semester and 2016-17 I semester were declared in this academic year. In the II semester results based on the pass percentages, ECE department has topped in third year, EEE department has topped in second year, and CSE department has topped in first year. In 2016-17 I semester results, CIVIL department has topped in fourth year, EEE department has topped in third year, CSE department has topped in second year, and IT department has topped in first year results.

This year the college has taken the initiative to introduce new interactive teaching learning mechanisms for the first year students in order to improve the involvement of students in learning and help them perform well in academics. Mechanisms such as Group Discussions, Student Seminars, Quizzes, Debates, Case Studies, and Role plays were used to teach the subjects in the curriculum along with conventional teaching methods.

Campus placements is a perpetual activity and the college gives it utmost importance. Campus Recruitment Training is conducted on a regular basis in coordination with our central placements department. Personality development training sessions were conducted for all the first and final year students. Until now, more than twenty companies have conducted on campus placement drives. Genpact, Amazon, IBM, Sutherland, Purpletalk, ICICI, Kasturi Infotech, Braodridge, VAM Labs, Spoors Technologies, Intone Networks, Infobahn, RIHU Software, Kony India, etc have recruited more than 150 students in this academic year. Many more reputed companies are yet to visit our college for on campus placement drives very soon.

Today, in addition to its continued academic excellence, the nation looks up to the academic institutions to address some of its major problems and to lead to a better and promising future. These include concerns about all round sustainability including safety and security, food and nutrition, shelter and habitat, energy and environment, and

economy and employment. Moreover, the higher education academic institutions are now mandated to be able to spread their educational excellence beyond the boundaries of the Institutions and reach out to a much larger number of people requiring quality education. Our students have responded to this challenge by taking up the initiative of visiting the nearby government schools, slums and orphanages to render their services with possible means and resources.

Our NSS volunteers attended National, State level and JNTUH youth festivals, International Youth Exchange Programme between India-China, National Integration Camp, Swami Vivekananda Band Camp, Skill Development camp etc. Our NSS unit has conducted various programmes like Telangana Haritha Haram, Swach Bharath, Shramdan, Pulse Polio, Blood Donation Camp, Republic day Celebrations in the adopted Government School, visit to old age homes, and awareness programmes on Anti-ragging. A donation of Rs 15,000/- was given by our students to Indian Society for Blind. A week long Village camp was conducted at Vailalapally, Narayanpur mandal, Nalgonda district. It involved testing fluorine in drinking water, cleaning of open drainages, conduct of Eye and Dental Camps, cleaning of school campuses, repairing roads, and awareness programmes on Digital transactions.
